## WHERE IS GOD WHEN WE SUFFER?

This is a question that has plagued humanity for centuries. There are no easy answers as suffering is unique to each individual, family, and community. It is never easy to nail down the reason or understand the reason even if revealed to us. The human mind can always counter the reason as suffering is not innate to humanity as much as pleasure and comfort. Many people have either strayed away from God or found meaning and purpose through suffering. The scope of this article is not to provide answers as to why we suffer but help us to understand what we can do when we suffer and know where we can find God and therefore meaning during our suffering.

In Psalm 107:6,13,19,28, the psalmist says, "Then they cried out to the Lord in their trouble, and he brought them out of their distress." The only one who can help us navigate suffering is God himself. Whatever the reason for our suffering, when we reach out to the Lord, He is more than able to navigate us.

There may be moments when we may struggle to even reach out to the Lord, which is when the support of the community of faith helps us. God chose the way of immense physical and emotional suffering to redeem humanity though He could have chosen some other way. The cross therefore becomes the principal place where we can meet God during our suffering. Therefore, the answer to where God is when we suffer, is that He is suffering with us, because He suffered.
